MEDICAL FORM

Parents/guardians must MAIL a completed medical form including all immunizations at least TWO WEEKS prior to the child's first day. The child must have a well visit within one year of the particular camp session he or she is attending. Once we have received your application, you will receive an e-mail confirmation letter along with the medical form. Campers will not be permitted to attend UBC unless the completed medical form is received. You may also download the form from our website (universitybasketballcamp.com).

TUITION

Each camper receives ONE UBC jersey regardless of how many weeks they attend. At the completion of each session, campers receive a written evaluation and award certificate. There are daily camp prizes and awards at the conclusion of each session. Each camper also receives team and individual instruction. Parents are required to provide health care insurance. Camp tuition is \$295 per week. Girls Session 2 is \$240 for the mini-week. (Closed on July 4th).
